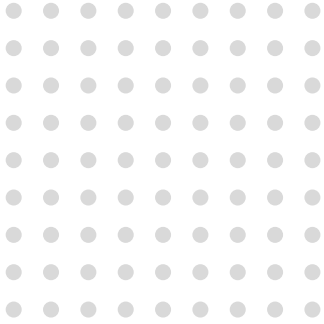

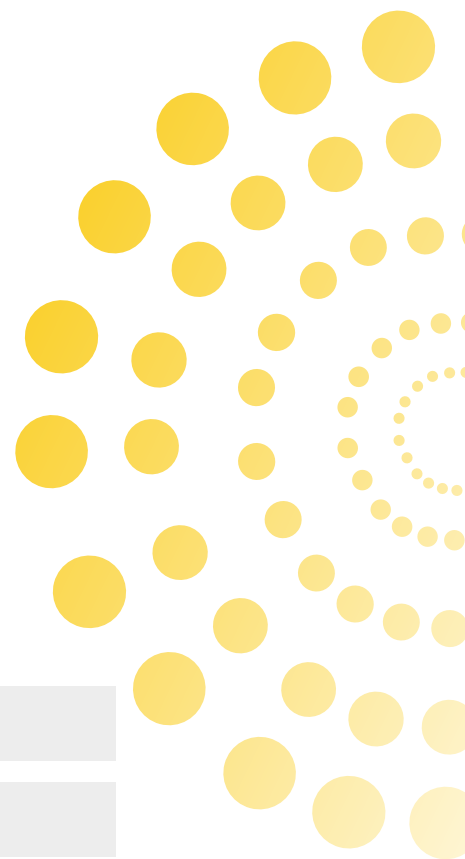

don’t come easy”



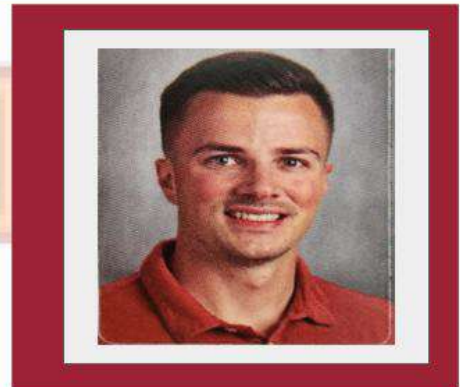
You have to work hard to complete your goals Ms. Farmer worked hard to find her teaching job. She applied to 145 different schools.
